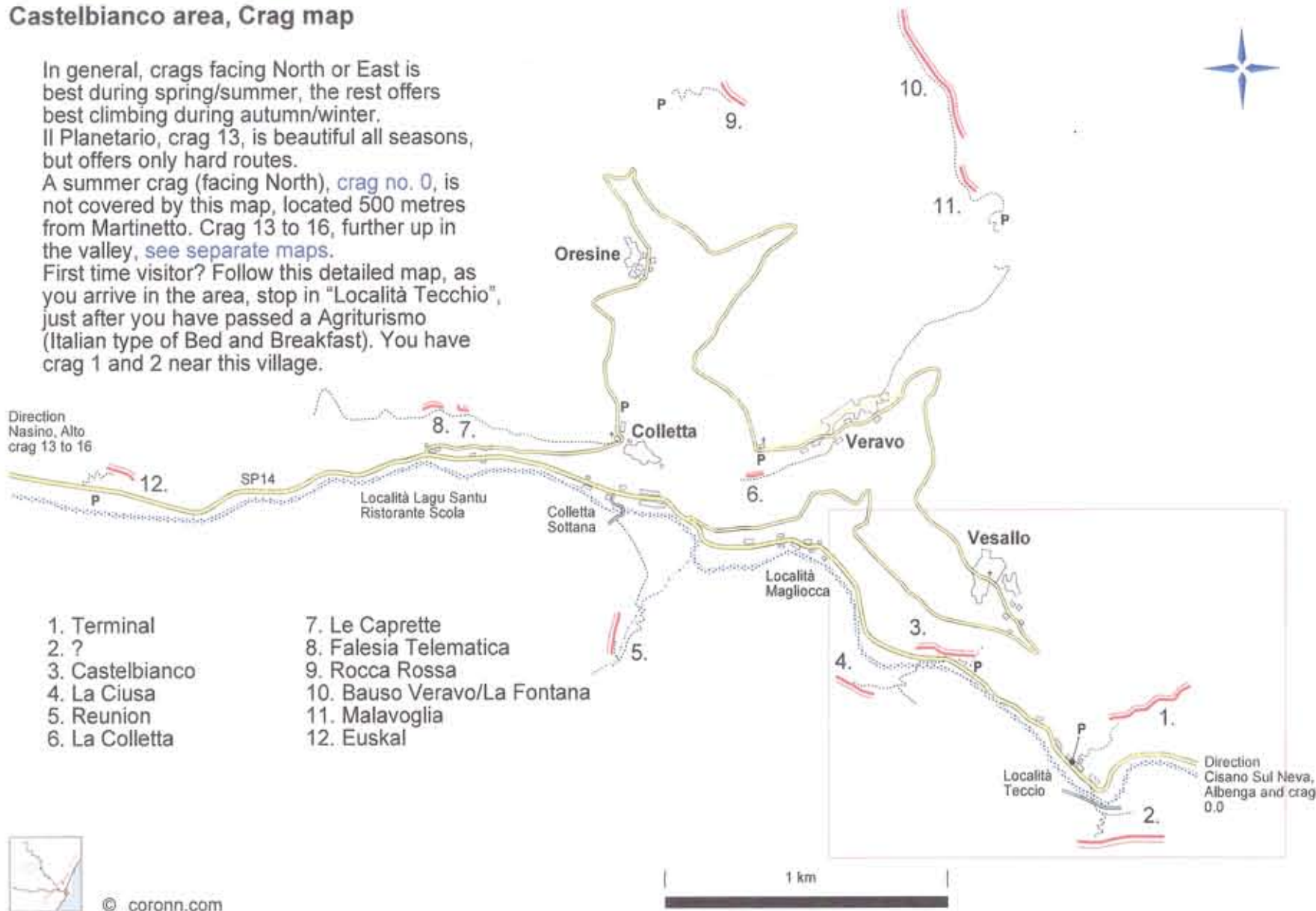




Castelbianco area, Crag map

In general, crags facing North or East is best during spring/summer, the rest offers best climbing during autumn/winter.
 Il Planetario, crag 13, is beautiful all seasons, but offers only hard routes.
 A summer crag (facing North), crag no. 0, is not covered by this map, located 500 metres from Martinetto. Crag 13 to 16, further up in the valley, see separate maps.
 First time visitor? Follow this detailed map, as you arrive in the area, stop in "Località Tecchio", just after you have passed a Agriturismo (Italian type of Bed and Breakfast). You have crag 1 and 2 near this village.



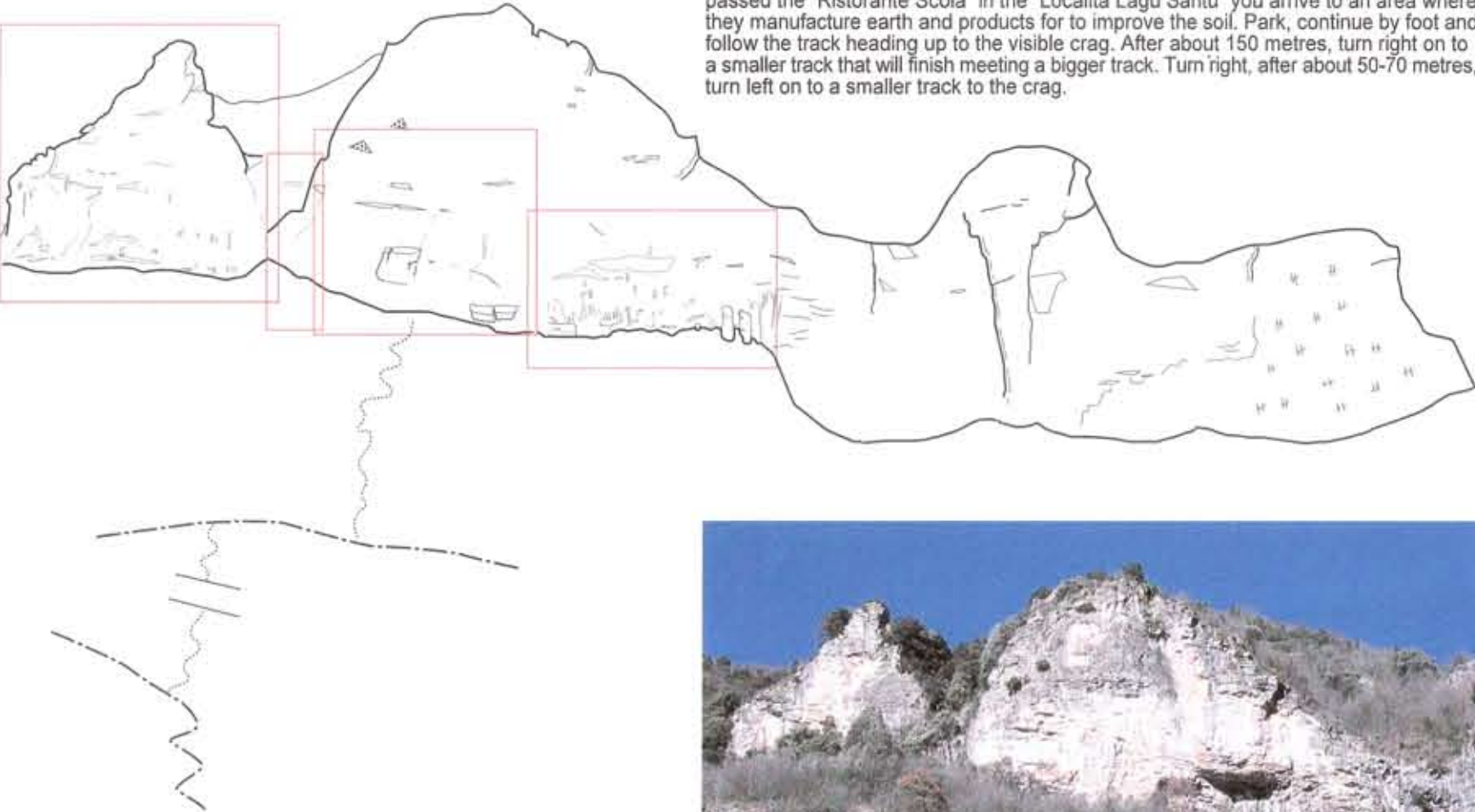

How to find the crag:

Pass the Castelbianco area and continue in the direction of Nasino. 1 km after you have passed the "Ristorante Scola" in the "Località Lagu Santu" you arrive to an area where they manufacture earth and products for to improve the soil. Park, continue by foot and follow the track heading up to the visible crag. After about 150 metres, turn right on to a smaller track that will finish meeting a bigger track. Turn right, after about 50-70 metres, turn left on to a smaller track to the crag.



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
